GREATER KANSAS CITY ANNUAL COMMUNITY RESOURCE FAIR:

For 5 years, the Jackson County Children's Division (JCCD) and Cornerstones of Care have presented an annual Resource Fair. What started in a small gymnasium, meant to increase public child welfare staff knowledge about local resources, became an annual event that showcases the resources of more than 175 local agencies to over 1,000 family members and service providers

MFCAA - UMKC SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK: CHILDREN AND THEIR MANY FAMILIES ANNUAL CONFERENCE:

For many years, the Midwest Foster Care and Adoption Association organized an annual conference designed to enhance knowledge and skills for foster parents. Beginning in 2008, MFCAA joined UMKC's School of Social Work and expanded this conference's focus to also include exploration of innovative, collaborative practice and service integration.

CORNERSTONES OF CARE ANNUAL ADOPTION FORUM:

Since 2007, Cornerstones of Care has highlighted National Adoption Month by sponsoring a day-long adoption forum for child welfare service providers that brings nationally recognized experts to present innovative approaches and emerging knowledge regarding adoption.

 - Intended to provide individuals working directly with children an array of strategies and techniques to enhance their skills in care giving and developing support for children and families.
 - Target audience: Biological, foster, or adoptive parents; social workers, clinicians, residential/group home providers, school counselors.
