

Keeping Children Safe at Home

Intensive in-home services is a 4-6 week crisis intervention program that helps families avert the out-of-home placement of children due to juvenile delinquency, mental illness, substance abuse, family violence, abuse, and neglect.

We spend **8-10 hours per week** with the family to help families improve functioning and safety so they may remain together.

Bringing Children Safely Home

Intensive family reunification services is an 8-12 week program for families whose child has been removed from the home due to safety concerns.

We spend **8-10 hours per week** with the family to build on family strengths, address areas of concern, create transition plans, and support the family during the child's safe transition home.

Families in Both Programs Receive:

- Strengths-based teams certified in traumainformed care who are available 24/7.
- Individually customized interventions.
- Help improving problem-solving, parenting, communication, coping, and other skills.
- Connections to community resources.

Eligibility Requirements

- Referral from Missouri Children's Division.
- Families live in the counties we serve (visit cornerstonesofcare.org/youth for details).

Additional IFRS Requirements:

- Safety concerns have been resolved.
- The child has contact with the family.
- The court agrees on the child returning home.
